Over the coming weeks I will be taking off-leash groups out on Wednesdays, too. If anyone is interested in booking a Wednesday spot let me know asap!

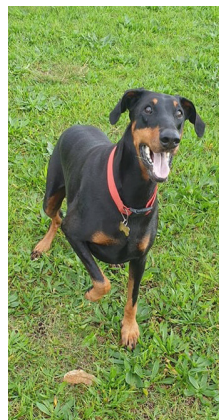
On-leash walks are full
